



Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater Tour. Spring 2017

We are planning a trip to **Fallingwater**.

Who can go on the trip? All students in the department are eligible

When is the trip? Monday, May 29, 2017 – Friday, June 2nd.

- We will drive on Monday afternoon, and spend the night in Indiana.
- On Tuesday May 30th we'll drive to Fallingwater, Pennsylvania. At noon we will visit Kentuck-Knob, a house by Frank Lloyd Wright near Fallingwater. Following the visit, we will check into the newly built facility for students. Designed by BCJ Architects, this new facility will be our base in this visit. We will begin the workshop on the afternoon. Following the workshop, we will take a walk to the Fallingwater house and spend some time observing, sketching and learning about the site and the house.
- On Wednesday, May 31, we will spend half of the day in Fallingwater, which is closed to visitors on that day. So the house will be "ours" for most of the day. After lunch, we will get back to the base and continue the workshop.

- On Thursday, June 1st we will finalize the workshop with a student presentation and start driving back to Missouri late in the afternoon. We will stop for the night in Springfield Ohio.
- On the next morning, Friday, June 2nd we will visit the Westcott house by Frank Lloyd Wright in Springfield Ohio. Following the visit, we will drive back to Columbia, Missouri.

How much it will cost? The whole package, including workshops, visit to three Frank Lloyd Wright Houses, lodging, and food will cost **\$560** per student. You'll need to bring your own pillows and bed-sheets.

The trip is limited for 20 participants. Students who plan to register for the Summer Studio (ArchSt 4813 or 4823) are encouraged to join the trip.
